About the Institute

The institute has come into existence as an essential need of the neighborhood society, especially working class community. Accordingly, Higher Education Formal, Open (ODL) and Extension mode is offered with utility specializations and entire flexible mobility in 1983. As per vision, since last 32 years, the institute has been pursuing to empower the deprived weaker, workers and minority men & women sections of the society and it has achieved great sucess by adopting distinct motto 'Work is Worship'. The institute is affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur and is eligible to receive assistance from U.G.C. under section 2 F & 12 B of the U.G.C. Act of 1956. The institution achieved 2.80 CGPA in Third Cycle Re-assessment & accreditation by NAAC in Feb. 2016

Distinctive Features of the Institution:

1) Courses:

- 2) Career Oriented Courses: Following career oriented courses are approved by the UGC under C.O.C. Schemes.

Note: The student seeking admission to formal B.A./B.Com. Degree course can get admission to Vocational (Need Based) Skill Oriented courses of Adult & Continuing Education Deptt. Shivaji University, Kolhapur & the Career Oriented Courses simultaneously without any inconvenience.

- 3) Vocational / Skill Oriented Course: The institute runs the vocational & skill oriented course of Adult & Continuing Education & Extension Department, Shivaji University, Kolhapur, under the extension education mode. i.e. Certificate Course in Library Management.
- 4) Open Education Mode Study Center Courses: The institute runs B.A., B.Com degree courses, B.A. (Mass Communication, Journalism), M.A. Marathi, M.A. English, M. Com & M.B.A. courses under the open (ODL) mode of YCMOU, Nashik

- 5) Internal Quality Assurance Cell: This cell is formed to monitor overall institutional activities for quality enhancement and sustainance as per the guidelines and suggestions of NAAC. The cell identifies quality benchmarks to achieve excellence in the institute.
- 6) Academic Calender: The institute prepares exhaustive academic calender annually considering the academic schedule of the Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The institute organizes all the curricular, co-curricular and extra curricular activities which are planned in advance through academic calender.
- 7) Student Centre teaching-learning process: The institute has come into existence as a need based institute to impart HE to the stagnated and drop out students. Hence it has adopted student centric teaching learning process for multidimensional development of the students. All the functions and activities of the institute are marching towards the student centric teaching learning process. For this purpose, various committees, cells & clubs are formed. These are as under:
- a) The College Students Council: Students council will be formed as per the Maharashtra Universities Act 2016 Clause 99 (1) (3) to look after the welfare of the students and it helps to promote, co-ordinate and participate in various curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the institute.
- b) Students Guidance and Counseling Cell: This cell provides guidance and counseling services to the students for their personality development regarding their academic and personal problems through psychological approach.
- c) Placement and Promotion Cell: As per motto of the institute "Work is Worship" this cell provides placement opportunities to the students in private industries as well as public sectors.
- d) Research Committee: This committee works under the guidance of expert research scholars to develop research attitude and approach among the faculty and students.
- e) Adult & Continuing Education Committee: This committee provides various need based, skill oriented & vocational courses to the students and the neighborhood community to enhance their employability.
- f) Competitive Examination Committee: This committee provides guidance & counseling facilities regarding various competitive examinations. The committee makes the students competent to face various competitive examinations successfully. The contact sessions and coaching classes are conducted on holidays besides the regular working hours of the institute.

- g) Elocution & Debating Committee: This committee organizes various competitions like elocution, debating, essay writing, quiz etc. to crate competitive spirit and global competencies among the students.
- h) Women Cell: This cell functions under the guidance of women faculty members to provide guidance & counseling services to the women students. Various functions and activities are organized by the cell to boost women empowerment and gender equality spirit.
- i) Sexual Harassment Prevention Committee: This committee is established for protecting against sexual harassment of women staff and students in the institutional campus and providing various counseling services to them regarding their safety.
- j) Hiking and Nature Club: This Club is formed to develop the spirit of adventure in students and to cultivate the study of nature with research purpose and protecting the environment. The club organizes adventures, expeditions such as to visit various forts, historical and geographical remote places independently or in collaboration with local organizations / NGO's formed for the same purpose.
- k) Sports and Physical Education Committee: The institute has well-equipped sports department for indoor and outdoor games to make the students physically fit and to prepare them for various sports competitions by providing special expertise coaching facilities and financial assistance to the outstanding sports students.
- I) Cultural Committee: The institution has cultural department functioning under the expert faculty. This department promotes presentation of the hidden cultural talents among students like acting, drama, one-act play, street play, singing, dancing etc. which are essential to develop and enrich the personalities of the students.
- m) Student Grievance Redressal Cell: The institute has constituted the Grievance Redressed Cell to redress the problems of the students regarding teaching-learning process, evaluation process, administrative problems, infrastructual facilities etc. provided by the institute collected through the complaints box and considering these complaints, appropriate remedies are suggested to the concerned.
- n) Special Cell: This cell is formed as per the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 for welfare of the faculty and students belonging to backward classes.
- o) Lead College Committee: Considering the dimensional development of the students, we organized workshops on the various subjects.
- p) Students Counselling & Guidance Cell: Considering the Pendamic desease Covid-19. The Said Committee is constituted as per the directions of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The Prime Function is to create awareness among the Students and give necessary guidance to the students.

- 8) Modern Teaching Aids and Tools: The institute uses various contemporary and modern Pedagogical teaching aids and tools like Smart Boards / Digital Class projector, computer, internet & audio-visual aids etc. for enriching and supplementing the traditional teaching learning process to have effective learning experiences for the students. These modern teaching aids and tools are made an integral part of the institutional teaching learning process.
- 9) Continuous Internal Assessment & Evaluation Scheme: The institute is always aware of the multi-dimentional development of the students and considering this, continuous and cumulative internal assessment and evaluation scheme is followed by the institute i.e. tutorials, unit tests, class tests, home assignments twice in the year. It is integral part of continuous Internal Assessment and Evaluation Scheme.
- 10) Mechanism for Mentoring of the students: The students Guidance and Counseling cell, Competitive Examination and Guidance Committee, Placement Cell etc. are the major mechanisms to mentor the students for their all round development. Besides this various lectures of eminent persons from various fields are organized to mentor the students regarding their career.
- 11) Mechanism to receive feedback from students: The institute has effective mechanism to receive various types of feed back from students i.e. feedback on curriculum, overall faculty performance, infra structural facilities, time-table, lectures process, administrative facilities etc. through various means and interactional functioning to achieve excellence.
- 12) Students Feedback Mechanism: The institute has provision to nominate student representatives on various academic and administrative committees as a part of participative administrative technique, i.e. Grievance Redressal cell, Students Council, Anti-Sexual Herassment Committee, Discipline Committee etc.
- 13) Computerized Central Library: Our library is well stacked with adequate reference books, text-books, journals, magazines etc. It is well equipped and computerized as well as connected with advanced internet services. Students and faculty are provided free access services in the library. Reprographics facility is available in the library.
- 14) Well-equipped psychology Laboratory: The institute has well equipped psychology laboratory. The faculty members of the Psychology Department are always engaged in counseling activities for the students.

- 15) Well-equipped Language Laboratory: The well equipped language laboratory is recently developed, to enrich the knowledge and communication skills of the students having language subjects, as an effective learning resource.
- 16) Well-equipped Gymnasium: The institute has well equipped gymnasium with adequate equipments and expertise coaching facilities for the exercise to the students, useful for their physical fitness, health and hygiene. A diet chart and other information in this regard is also displayed for the same purpose.
- 17) Parent Teachers Association and Alumni Association: Institute has registered Parent Teachers Association and Alumni association to receive all types of assistance and feed back for all round development of the institute.
- 18) Active Management: The institutional management is pro-active and devoted for multi-dimensional development of the institute. Adequate infra structural facilities and welfare schemes are provided in campus for staff and students along with the recruitment of qualified and component faculty for achieving conducive environment in institutional teaching learning process.
- 19) Expert and Devoted Faculty and Staff: The institute has competent and well-qualified faculty and staff to run all the academic and administrative functions effectively and efficiently. There are Eleven Ph. D. holders and Nine have M. Phil as their research qualification, whereas four are qualified NET/SET, six are recognized as post-graduate teachers in the existing faculty.
- 20) Expertise available for Consultancy Services: All the faculty members of the institute provide consultancy services to the students and the neighborhood community as experts related to the subjects and fields. All these consultancy services are provided free of cost.
- 21) Annual Social Gathering: The Annual Social Gathering is the main feature of the institute. The institute organizers "Annual Social Gathering and Prize Distribution Function" to felicitate the meritorious and outstanding sports and cultural students, to motivate the students all round development.
- 22) Annual Magazine "Nishant": The institute publishes "Nishant" magazine annually to encourage and involve the students for creative written materials and to express themselves in the form of literature. The institute provides opportunities to publish the selected creative materials through this magazine.

- 23) Award for Ideal Student: The institute has a provision to award "Ideal Student" to the deserving students. Procedure, norms and conditions in this regard are transparent and any common student can achieve this award on the basis of his/her academic performance other activities centrum to collage etc. and behaviors in the institute.
- 24) Various Teaching Learning Methods: Various teaching learning methods are used as supplementary to conventional lecture method by the institute to make the process student centric, efficient and effective, like question answer method, group discussion, quiz competition, guest lecture, student seminar, study tour, field/industrial visit, project based teaching method, audio visual aids based teaching method, interactive teaching learning method etc.

Various facilities and welfare schemes for the students

The institute provides various facilities and welfare schemes for the different strata of the society as under:

- a) Students from Deprived community: The institute provides adequate facilities to the students from this sections i.e. enough seats are reserved in the admissions as per the Reservation Policy of the state Govt. Various scholarships and schemes are provided to the students from this category.
- b) Economically weaker section: The institute pays special attention to provide adequate facilities to the economically weaker sections of the society. Along with EBC scheme, special concession in fees with convenient instalments for admission fee and other financial assistance through Student Aid Fund to overcome their financial problems.
- c) Students from minority community: The institute takes special efforts to provide higher education to the minority community. Priority is given in admission to such students. Similarly remedial teaching classes are conducted as UGC scheme for difficult subjects to the students from this community.
- d) Outstanding Students in Sports and Cultural Activities: The institute takes special care of the outstanding sports and cultural students and attempts to enhance their performance in various sports and cultural activities. Various facilities are provided to such students like priority in admission, concession in fees, expertise coaching, facility, financial aids, sports kit etc. Reservation for sports candidates will be as per government of Maharashta Rules.

- e) Differently Abled Students: The institute provides easy access to the differently abled students as the reservation policy of the State Govt. and the guidelines, rules and regulations of the university. The institute provides various essential facilities to these students such as special toilet, ramp, library facility, convenient, classroom access facility, scholarship as per Govt. rules, extra time provision at examination as per university rules etc.
- f) Female Students: 30% Reservation for female Candidates. The institute specially takes care of women students. The reservation policies of State Govt. and rules and regulations of the university are followed strictly by the institute for women students admission. The institute pays special attention to provide essential facilities to women students such as Women Cell and Sexual Harassment Prevention Committee for providing guidance and counseling services to the women students regarding their academic, individual and special problems etc. The institute takes care to the security of women students at night in the premises of the institute.
- g) Facilities for Slow and Advanced Learners: The institute has mechanism to identify the slow and advance learner students on the basis of their previous years academic performance & class room interaction. Subject wise "Special remedial teaching" for slow learner and "Special coaching classes" for advanced learners are provided to improve their knowledge and to achieve distinction respectively. - h) Study Room facility: Study room facility is provided to the students at night who have no adequate facilities at their home as per requirement.

A) Criterion for Admission: Considering the vision & mission statements of the institute & as per the rules and regulations of Shivaji University as well as Govt. of Maharashtra admission are given based on inter se merit. After the scheduled date of admissions, if seats remain vacant, the criterion of "first come first served" is adopted for admission.

Admissions are given as per the Govt. of Maharashtra rules regarding percentage of reservation i.e. 50% & 50% for open. As per the Maharashtra Government 30% seats are reserved for female students and 3% seats are reserved for dis-ablead. As per Govt. rules, 10% seats are reserved for wards of ex. serviceman, 5% seats are reserved for sportsman & 1 seat is reserved for Jammu & Kashmir student. After the scheduled date of admission, if reserved category seats remain vacant, these seats will be filled from open category.

B) Eligibility:

- a) A student who has passed any one of the following examination is eligible for admission at B.A./B.Com. Part-I
 - 1) H.S.C. Exam (12th Standard) 10+2
 - 2) H.S.C. Exam. with MCVC
 - 3) Diploma in Pharm. (D. Pharma)

 - 5) D.Ed.
 - 6) I.T.I. (2 years Course)
- b) Every student seeking admission for B.A.-I & B.Com -I class is required to fill up eligibility form to get eligibility certificate from Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The prescribed forms are available in the office.
- C) Admission Schedule: Considering the admission and eligibility schedule of the Shivaji University, the institute declares admission schedule for B.A./B.Com I classes as under,

Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999

(Maharashtra Act No XXXIII of 1999)

"Ragging" means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and it includes-

- 1) Teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to, such student; or
- 2) Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly, do.
- 3)Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- 4) Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to the fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- 5) Student convicted of such offence, under section 4, he/she shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.




